PROGRAMME NOTES

Sweet Hop is a piece for recorder quartet based on a chord progression which can be heard throughout the piece. The name is derived from two features of the piece; the word "sweet" referring to the sound of the recorder and the word "hop" referring to the constant crotchets played throughout the piece.

Sweet Hop is a galliard. A galliard is a dance, and the very consistent and meaningful articulation in this piece reflects the dance form. Underneath this, the harmony is based on jazz harmony, and the melody is inspired by minimalism. So in short, *Sweet Hop* is a Jazz Minimalist Galliard. -Adam Spry
